

Old Home Day Committee **Minutes of Meeting July 22, 2015** 1 pm at the Library

Called to order at 1:10 pm

Beer Tent: Don is contacting breweries and other sponsors. Proceeds will be split between Town Hall and Theatre Restoration Project and the Congregational Church.

Prior meeting: At the July 15 meeting, group went through list of last year's vendors and events to determine what we wanted to repeat. John will be updating the spreadsheet and will send it out to everyone. Set vendor space at \$50 for Saturday, \$75 for Saturday and Sunday. Vendors will be set up 10-4 both days. (no minutes available from this meeting, as secretary was absent.)

Tents: Tom is still checking on rental possibilities.

Contra Dance: Carolyn Parrott has agreed to the \$100 cancellation fee if we cancel. Larger tent will allow the dance to be under cover.

Sunday: Need to settle that we are doing events on Sunday. Consensus was we have enough ideas to fill the afternoon. Sunday will begin with a pancake breakfast served by the Fire Explorers of Dunbarton and Goffstown (contact is Tammy Bowne), followed by a community worship service under the tent. Will try to involve both churches in town. (Need a contact for St. John's.)

George has booked the Bel Airt for Sunday afternoon. They will play for 2 hours for \$650. Also in contact with Lizz Ferdina regarding Spireside regulars who might be available and/or the "Just in Time" choir.

Antique Cars: There is a big rally that weekend in Concord, so may not be able to get many out here. Could we suggest that they "tour" through Dunbarton on Sunday afternoon?

John noted that he will regrettably be out of town from September 5 until after Old Home Day. Others will review his notes and spreadsheets to be ready to deal with any crisis that may develop. Let John know what has been booked so he can keep the spreadsheets up to date for schedule and expenses.

Kids' Space: Plan is to have bounce houses and crafts on Saturday, and old fashioned games and races on Sunday.

Publicity: We need to start designing signs to go around town and in surrounding towns, and a 'save the date' postcard. Collect ideas for the next meeting.
