The 250<sup>th</sup> Committee needs about 10 minutes to place items in the new time capsule. Decided that there would be sufficient time at 2:30 on Saturday while the bands changed to do the time capsule, and that will work for the committee.

Tent: Rental is \$900 for a 30x60 tent, plus about \$150 for delivery and set up, for a total of \$1050. Tom will continue to check on buying a tent, but we will probably have to go with the rental this year.

Bounce Houses, chairs, and tables: Ordered from Taylor Rental. Tom will send them last year's invoice and add the extra tables and chairs we need. He will also check what they have for an extra 20x40 tent. Dan Van Kalken has 7 round tables that we can borrow.

Parade permit has been issued. The 250<sup>th</sup> Committee is looking for a couple of kids to carry the new town flag. They have 100 small versions to hand out to children.

Parade laws: No throwing candy from floats or vehicles. OK to have someone walking hand candy to children. Floats carrying children under 16 years old must have a 3 ft.

high railing. Driver pulling float is responsible for anything happening on the float, and should have communication set up with someone on the float. Tom will run off guidelines to be posted.

Bingo: Sunday 2-4 in the "kid's tent". Nancy will get the supplies.

Fireworks: JR is on board, Ken will contact him about mowing the field, what are the requirements, and who can help.

Banners and Signs: about \$500. 10 3x5 vertical banners and 50 "campaign" signs. 250<sup>th</sup> Committee will check their budget and may be able to contribute to the sign costs. Signs should be in on Wednesday, being shipped to the Town Office.

Electrician: John will follow up. Steven Dodd is not available, and the cord covers, etc. are all spoken for that weekend. Tom has a contact in Dover who might be able to help for free or low cost.

Soda tasting: Garden Club is buying soda from Swampscot, and Tom is getting free soda from Portland.
